Mrs. A. V. N. College, Visakhapatnam is an age-old institution in India founded by the late Sri. Ankitham Venkata Narasingarao in 1860, with a cause to help the deprived in educating their children. The college has been functioning under the chairmanship of the Collector and District Magistrate (at present Dr.A Mallikharjuna, IAS) since its inception.

Mrs.A.V.N.College is an A.P. government aided college, now a private college. It has been recognised under section 12(b) and 2(f) of UGC Act since the inception of University Grants Commission in 1956. The college has been reaccredited (3rd Cycle) by NAAC with "A" grade in September 2017. Many great personalities like Sir.C.V.Raman, Padmavibhushan Prof.C.R.Rao are the alumni of this institution.
