

5. change habit of excessive use of mobile
6. During cell phone conversation, reduce movement as little as possible.

Solution :- enable the airplane mode for at least

1. Minute. Then try to connect again. occasionally you can turn off and on the connection that is failing and then try to connect it again.

4. Slow phone

Solution :- Close/delete apps. files and clear the cache data.

5. Bad battery life

Solution :- enable the battery saving mode and see if your battery lasts longer. Check your battery usage in your phone settings and see which apps are using more battery. you can close or disable the ones that are draining more battery if you usually do not need them.

In animals, chronic exposure to wifi radiation caused behavioural alterations, liver enzyme impairment, Psychotic nucleus, concluded that the mobile, phone radiation may increased the reactive oxygen species, which plays an important role in the development of metabolic and neurodegenerative diseases.
