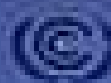

Our team had claimed approximately certain tons through cleaning and clearing the plastic and some of the wastages near ocean waves which could harm the ocean and environment. The activities that we had done in Community Service project includes Swachh Bharat, Blood donation, Tree plantation, Survey had done. The brief about this is below in this paragraph.

* Swachh Bharat :-

Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM), Swachh Bharat Abhiyan or Clean India Mission is a Country wide Campaign initiated by the Government of India in 2014 to eliminate open defecation and improve Solid waste management. It is a restructured version of the Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan launched in 2009 carried through by Successor Manmohan Singh.

Initiated by the government of India, the mission aimed to achieve an "Open Defecation Free" (ODF) India by 2 October 2019, the 150th anniversary of the birth of Mahatma Gandhi through construction of toilets. An estimated 89.9 million toilets were built in the period. "Clean India Mission" the Campaign was officially launched on 2 October 2014 at

The mission is aimed at progressing towards target 6.3 of the Sustainable Development Goals Number 6 established by the United Nations in 2015. At a rally in Champaran, the Prime Minister called the campaign *Satyagrah Se Swachhagrah* in reference to Gandhi's Champaran Satyagrah launched on 10 April 1916. The mission was split into two - Rural and Urban. In rural areas "SBM - Gramin" was financed and monitored through the Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation, whereas "SBM - Urban" was overseen by the 'Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs'. As a part of the Campaign, volunteers, known as *Swachhagrahis*, or "Ambassadors of cleanliness" promoted the construction of toilets using a popular method called Community-led Total Sanitation at the village level. Other activities included national real-time monitoring and updates from non-governmental organizations such as Waste Warriors.

* Tree Plantation :-

Tree plantation means planting trees and plants. The purpose of tree plantation is save the endangered environment and to beautify our life. Trees are valuable gifts of nature. They are known as best friends of every human being. They benefit us in various ways. The lives of man and other animals and insects are inconceivable without the existence of trees in the world. Trees absorb carbon dioxide and give us oxygen without which no living being can live. Trees give us shade, medicine, food, fruits, furniture, fuel etc.. Trees also keep the weather cool and cause rainfall. They also bind soil and thus prevent erosion. The land of Bangladesh is suitable for the plantation of different kinds of trees. Trees can be planted in the vast areas of sea beaches.

The villagers use their unused land by planting trees. June and July are the proper time for planting trees in our country. Trees are part and parcel of our life - so, it is our duty to plant more trees and take care of them in order to maintain balance between man and nature. To make the country economically developed and to save the globe from green house effect, we should plant trees on a large scale tree plantation.

* Blood Donation :

A blood donation occurs when a person voluntarily has blood drawn and used for transfusions or made into biopharmaceutical medications by a process called fractionation. Donation may be of whole blood or of specific components only directly. Blood banks often participate in the collection process as well as the procedures that follow it.

Today in the developed world most blood donors are unpaid volunteers who donate blood for a community supply. In some countries, established supplies are limited and donors usually give blood when family or friends need a transfusion. Many donors donate for several reasons, such as a sense of charity, general awareness regarding the demand for blood, increased confidence in oneself, helping a personal friend or relative, and social pressure. Potential donors are evaluated for anything that might make their blood unsuitable for use. The screening includes testing for diseases that can be transmitted by a blood transfusion, including HIV and viral hepatitis. The donor must also answer questions about medical history and take a short physical examination to make sure the donation isn't hazardous to his or her health. The amount of blood drawn and the methods vary.

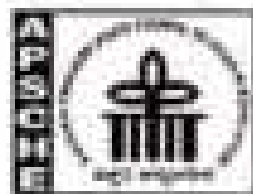
