CHAPTER 1: EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The main purpose of blood group testing is, we all should be aware of our blood groups. It plays a very important role when it comes to having a blood transfusion. Knowing our blood groups helps us to select appropriate blood for transfusion there during any emergencies or accidents.

In blood testing we should take materials like toothpicks, blood sample, Alcohol swabs, lancet, clean glass slide, sterile cotton bud, biohazard disposal container, monoclonal antibodies [Anti-A, B, and D] all these equipments will be readily available in a blood test tool kit. Then take a clean glass slide & draw three circles on it. unpack the monoclonal antibodies (mAb) kit in the first circle add Anti-A, to the second circle add Anti-B & to the third circle add Anti-D with the help of a dropper. Now wipe the ring finger with the alcohol swab and sub gently nail the fingering tip, where the blood sample will be collected. Lick the ring finger tip with the concert or wipe off the first drop of the blood. As samples gently with the help of toothpick & wait for a min. to observe

- * They don't consult doctor for the blood specific -
- caution tests.
- * Treated the upper caste community and the lower class community.
- * People are still following their blood groups according to their families.
- * There is monopoly single community in the surveyed area maximum.
- * Maximum people aged 20 above are seem to be alcoholic.
- * Gutted, pan, smoke will be chewed by the teen ages.
- * They don't donate their blood once by their fear.
- * Villagers/area people are still believing in useful superstitions.

- * Finally they can check up their blood group and check their blood percentage.
- * They can donate their blood at least 6 months once.
- * Stop using (or) drinking of alcohol.
- * Stop chewing of gutka, pan and paan.
- * Have minimum ideas on the "ABO" blood group system.
- * People stop believing of ancestral methods on body issues.
- * Regularly checkup their healthy issues with the doctors.
- * They can take good food and fruits for maintaining blood levels correctly.
- * They cannot use the chemicals/drugs to the body because they attack whole body.
