

PROBLEMS IN JALARIPETA :-

1. proper drainage system is not there
2. There is high chance of floods to this area during heavy rain as the water tank gets filled full of rain water and surplus water flows in to area (as village is besides this tank)
3. cleanliness means maintaining our surroundings, home and body neat and clean
4. neglecting garbage and various waste materials by not disposing of them properly
5. open defecation
6. open sewerage
7. drinking contaminated water
8. Failure to exterminate mosquitoes
9. open sewerage system
10. mosquitoes are a nuisance
11. water is wasted by negligence
12. open defecation : if this issue is not taken seriously which is very dangerous to people's health. The faeces excreted by flies and worms will enter the water and food and then enter the mouth and spread infections.

Short-term and long term action plan for possible solutions for the problems identified and that could be recommended to the concerned authorities for implementation.

SOLUTIONS FOR THE PROBLEMS OF JALARIPETA

- * proper drainage system should be laid in areas
- * some streets are not having street lights
- * some people are still living in very poor sanitary conditions
- * volunteers and ASHA workers should motivate and guide them about health and hygiene.
