In the reference 1st read above, the Member Secretary, A.P. Commission for backward classes has informed that irregularities have been committed in the regularisation of the services of Part Time Lecturers depriving the changes of absorption of persons who have been appointed by the duly constituted selection committees and also violating the communal roster. In the reference 2nd read above the Commission was informed that no violation of Communal roster has taken place in the regularisation of Part Time Lecturers and no irregularities have been committed as Government have issued certain guidelines for the said regularisation and also relaxed the rule of reservation wherever the Part Time Lecturer does not fit into by obtaining an undertaking from the Managements that the future vacancies would be filled in as per roster. However, the Commission was also informed that the post earmarked for appointment to B.C. 'C' Group should have been filled up by the Petitioner (Smt. Ch.M.S. Kumari) as member of B.C. 'C' Group and that in not so doing, there was a violation in the Rule of Reservation to B.C's.

In the reference IVth read above the Correspondent, Mrs. A.V.N. College, Visakhapatnam has reported that a vacancy would arise on 1-7-2001 due to retirement of Sri. S.A. Suryanarayana Lecturer in Telugu on 30-6-2001, and Smt. Ch.M.S. Kumari, un-aided Lecturer in Telugu may be absorbed against the said vacancy.

In the above circumstances after careful examination of the matter and since, Smt. Ch.M.S. Kumari, selected, through constituted selection committee in terms of G.O. 12, dated 10.1.92, to the post of Lecturer in Telugu against the Roster point of B.C. 'C', the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, A.P. Hyd is pleased to permit the Management to absorb Smt. Ch.M.S. Kumari, Lecturer in Telugu in the vacancy that arose due to the retirement of Sri. S.A. Suryanarayana, Reader in Telugu with prospective effect.

The Correspondent, Mrs. A.V.N. College, Visakhapatnam is requested to issue absorption orders to Smt. Ch. M. S. Kumari, as Lecturer in Telugu and then submit copies of absorption orders, joining report and the Annual Salary Statement for further necessary action.
