**O R D E R :**

In the G.O. 1st read above, 24 Junior Lecturers working in  
various Private Aided Composite Colleges in the State were  
re-designated as Lecturers since there is no cadre of Junior  
Lecturers in Composite Degree Colleges as these appointments were  
made in Lecturers posts and the individuals were fully eligible  
and qualified for appointments as Lecturers, subject to certain  
conditions prescribed therein, with prospective effect.

2. Sri S. Polayya, Smt. K.V. Lakshmi and N. Krishnaveni, Junior  
Lecturers of Mrs. A.V.N. College, Visakhapatnam have filed W.P.  
No. 16235/99 in the Hon'ble High Court praying for a direction  
to the Respondents for their re-designation as Lecturers from  
the date of their regular appointments i.e. 12.2.1996. The  
A.P. High Court in its order 2nd read above disposed of the W.P.  
with a direction to the respondents to re-designate the services  
of the petitioners (Junior Lecturers) as Lecturers w.e.f.  
12.2.1996.

3. The Commissioner & Director of Collegiate Education  
who was consulted in the matter, in his letter 3rd read above  
has stated that while furnishing proposals to Government during  
3/98, for re-designation of certain Junior Lecturers as Lecturers  
certain names were not included as information about their  
service was not made available by the respective Colleges.  
Accordingly the Commissioner and Director of Collegiate Education  
vide his letter 4th read above has furnished a list of 12 names  
including the names of 3 petitioners, for their re-designation  
as Lecturers as was done in respect of 24 persons vide G.O.  
Ms.No. 264, Dt. 22.10.1999.

4. While the matter was under examination in Government, the petitioners in W.P.No.16235/99 have filed C.C.No.1277/2000 against the non-implementation of the orders of A.P.High Court dt.17.11.1999 in W.P.No.16235/99.

5. The Government after careful examination of the proposal in detail, hereby re-designate the 12 Junior Lecturers mentioned in the Appendix to this order as Lecturers, since there is no cadre of Junior Lecturers in Composite Degree Colleges, and as these appointments were made in the Lecturers posts and the individuals were fully eligible and qualified for appointment as Lecturers. The redesignation orders shall be with prospective effect in respect of persons mentioned in the Annexure except Sl.Nos 1, 3 and 4. The petitioners as shown at Sl.Nos. 1, 3, & 4 in the Annexure who are covered by the Judgment of A.P.High Court dt.17.11.1999 in W.P.No.16235/99 are re-designated as Lecturers with effect from 12.02.1996 as ordered by the Hon'ble High Court.

6. The redesignation of the above Junior Lecturers as Lecturers is subject to fulfillment of the norms and qualifications needed for the posts of Lecturers by way of direct recruitment in the Private Aided Colleges in the State and concurrence of the A.P. College Service Commission be obtained wherever needed.

7. The additional expenditure if any, shall be met within the existing Budget provision during 2001-2002.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance and Planning (FW.EBS.VII) Department vide their U.O.No.39827-A/626/A2/EBS.7/2000, dt.15.11.2000.


