It has been recognised under section 12(b) and 2(f) of UGC Act since the inception of University Grants Commission in 1956. The college has been reaccredited (4th Cycle) by NAAC with“B++” grade in April 2024. Many great personalities like Sir.C.V.Raman,Padma Vibhushan Prof.C.R.Rao are the alumni of this institution.
